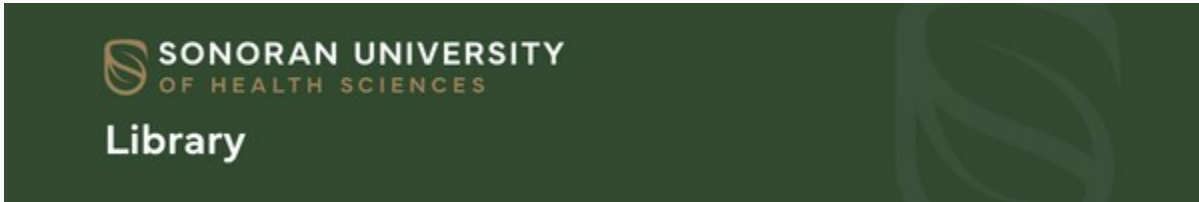

**ERASING THE WHITE BOARDS**

FreeMedicalJournals was created to promote the free availability of full text medical journals on the Internet. They welcome comments and suggestions. Currently this site has over 5088 medical journal back-issues, organized by topic or alphabetical, there are also many journals in a variety of languages. Many are available as downloadable PDFs, and some are available as mobile apps. There is also an app for the site in general. ## JOURNAL ARTICLES RESEARCH / INTERLIBRARY LOAN

**Journal Articles Research** : Learn about the several resources the Library subscribes to which will help you conduct a more successful research for Full Text Journal Articles. Search any of them separately, or utilize [iSearch](#) for a more comprehensive search of all of the Library's Journals resources. And when the Library's resources prove unsuccessful, then learn about the many Free databases and other online resources that could prove beneficial. Additionally, the Library Staff is happy to instruct you personally on how to conduct a thorough research in the Library's resources, and the resources easily available online elsewhere.

**Interlibrary Loan** : When all other options prove unsuccessful, then utilize the Sonoran University Library's Interlibrary Loan Services to obtain your most desired medical journal article. Be aware that the Library requires the most fundamental citation information for each article. Also, the Library has now created an online form as a third option for submitting article requests, when the features through PubMed and [iSearch](#) are not applicable. Please be aware that if you do not provide the necessary citation information, we will be unable to locate your requested article and be forced to reject and return your request to you for more information. Please be sure to exhaust all other options for locating an article before submitting a request to the Library.

# LWW Health Library

The **LWW Health Library** is a subscription-based resource, produced by the Wolters Kluwer / Lippincott Williams & Wilkins publishing company, that features leading medical content, plus multimedia, self-assessment, algorithms, case studies, and more. Of course, here at Sonoran University, it is most popular for the wealth of Ebooks content. To be clear, understand that only a select few medical books published strictly by the LWW publishing company will be found in this particular Database.

On the Library's MySonoran site, you will find the link to the LWW Health Library first in the "A-Z List of Library Resources" on the "Library Resources Databases Holdings" page. Be sure to click on it to link out to the Library LWW account page. It will take you right to the LWW Library of Medical Textbooks, many of which are required and/or recommended for your Basic Sciences, CLPR and various other Sonoran University Courses.

MacRepertory is our repertorization tool. It makes it easy to analyze each case, select rubrics and check the materia medica, providing the practitioner with confidence about their prescription.

The MacRepertory is a Homeopathic program only available on two computers in the Library; it is not available off campus. A special computer log-on is required; please ask for it from the Library staff. DO NOT use your personal computer log-on to access this program. You must use the unique Computer Log-on for access to this program. Also, FYI, you will not be able to print your work. However, you can use screen capture to create jpgs e-mail those to yourself; or you can save the jpgs on Word or PowerPoint docs.
