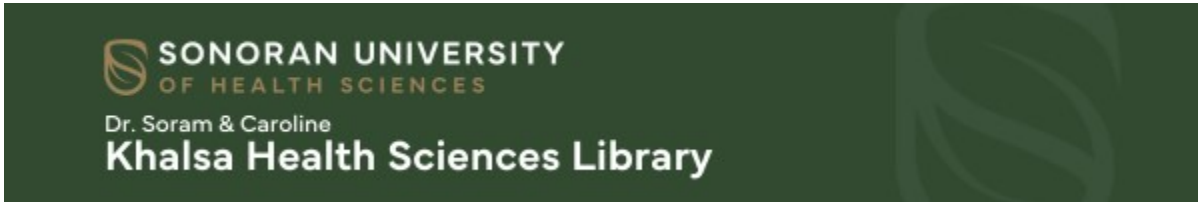

APA PsycTherapy is a streaming video database of therapy demonstrations with hundreds of videos showing various treatment approaches. APA PsycTherapy is intended for educational purposes, specifically in clinical training and counselor education, and provides clinicians, counselors, and trainees the opportunity to observe candid psychotherapy videos featuring known therapists.

This proven counseling training method is an invaluable tool to remain abreast of the latest psychotherapy techniques. Therapists cover more than 150 approaches, such as integrated behavioral healthcare, cognitive behavior therapy and acceptance and commitment therapy. All therapy demonstrations in APA PsycTherapy are unscripted and were taped within the past ten years.

LWW Health Library

The **LWW Health Library** is a subscription-based resource, produced by the Wolters Kluwer / Lippincott Williams & Wilkins publishing company, that features leading medical content, plus multimedia, self-assessment, algorithms, case studies, and more. Of course, here at Sonoran University, it is most popular for the wealth of Ebooks content. To be clear, understand that only a select few medical books published strictly by the LWW publishing company will be found in this particular Database.

On the Library's MySonoran site, you will find the link to the LWW Health Library first in the "A-Z List of Library Resources" on the "Library Resources Databases Holdings" page. Be sure to click on it to link out to the Library LWW account page. It will take you right to the LWW Library of Medical Textbooks, many of which are required and/or recommended for your Basic Sciences, CLPR and various other Sonoran University Courses.

These various resources include books in the Library collection, and links to resources on the internet.



Business Source Complete, provided by EBSCO, is a premium database with full-text content and peer-reviewed business journals. This database is an essential tool for business students. It covers all disciplines of business, including marketing, management, accounting, banking, finance and more. There are more than 2,000 active full-text journals and magazines, with more than 1,200 active, full-text, peer-reviewed journals, 760 active, full-text, peer-reviewed journals with no embargo, and 830 active full-text journals indexed in Web of Science or Scopus.



While this site might not provide you with all the specific medical journals you would wish, I highly recommend you check it out for a variety of great materials and a few surprises. FreeMedicalJournals was created to promote the free availability of full text medical journals on the Internet. They welcome comments and suggestions. Currently this site has over 5088 medical journal back-issues, organized by topic or alphabetical, there are also many journals in a variety of languages. Many are available as downloadable PDFs, and some are available as mobile apps. There is also an app for the site in general. KNOW YOUR BOOK

If you are unsure of the textbook you are coming to locate, having the course syllabi open on your electronic device will be most helpful to the staff.
