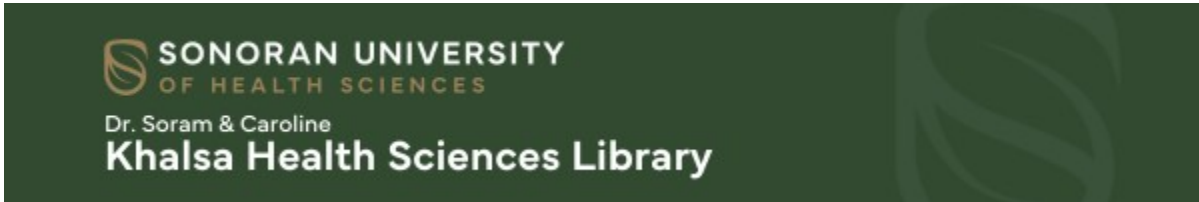

**APA PsycTHERAPY from EBSCO**

900 videos showing various treatment approaches.

APA PsycTherapy is a streaming video database of therapy demonstrations with hundreds of videos showing various treatment approaches. APA PsycTherapy is intended for educational purposes, specifically in clinical training and counselor education, and provides clinicians, counselors, and trainees the opportunity to observe candid psychotherapy videos featuring known therapists.

This proven counseling training method is an invaluable tool to remain abreast of the latest psychotherapy techniques. Therapists cover more than 150 approaches, such as integrated behavioral healthcare, cognitive behavior therapy and acceptance and commitment therapy. All therapy demonstrations in APA PsycTherapy are unscripted and were taped within the past ten years.

You can use **VisualDx** anytime while anywhere on campus through the Sonoran University wi-fi. You must link out from the link provided on the Library MySonoran web page. You can also get the Mobile App by creating an account while on campus.

## Get to Know VisualDx



### What is VisualDx?

It is a clinical decision support tool that enhances proficiency in:

- Pattern recognition
- Differential diagnosis
- Diagnostic reasoning
- Cultural competency



### Get the Mobile App

1. From a clinical computer on campus, go to [visualdx.com/institutional-signup](http://visualdx.com/institutional-signup). Follow the instructions.
2. Create a personal account username and password. **Note: You MUST complete this step before downloading the app.**
3. Search **VisualDx** in the App Store or Google Play. Download and enter the username and password you created in Step 2.



### Features

- 48,000 medical images across all skin types to aid diagnosis recognition.
- Handbook-length entries across general medicine including a Synopsis, What to Look For, Differential Diagnosis, Therapy, and more.
- A mobile quiz built to grow pattern-recognition skills.
- Efficiently search by chief complaint, diagnosis, medication, or travel location.

**Case Study**  
A 9-year-old boy with a history of allergic rhinitis and asthma presented for evaluation of a rash that had been recurring intermittently for the preceding 2 years. He noted that the rash was not itchy or painful. On examination, multiple discrete, follicularly-based, fine, scaly, tiny papules were seen on the elbows and knees. The patient had no systemic symptoms and appeared well otherwise.

**DIAGNOSIS LOOKUP**  
Search for a specific diagnosis to go straight to clinical information, images, and Symptomons™. Or click on a letter of the alphabet to see a list of available diagnoses.



**CME**  
Eligible users can earn .5 AMA PRA Category 1 credit with each activity in VisualDx. See and claim your credits here.\*

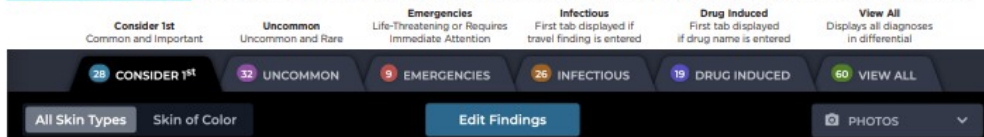
**BUILD A DIFFERENTIAL**  
Search by chief complaint, medication, or travel location to start building a custom differential for your patient.

**RECENT ACTIVITY**  
View all your recently searched diagnoses and custom-built differentials.

**SAVED ITEMS**  
Save a list of diagnoses you reference frequently.

**NOTE:** You must be signed in with your personal account to access the items under My VisualDx.

**DIFFERENTIAL RESULTS** 6 tabs are used to display results: Consider 1st, Consider 2nd, Emergencies, Infectious, Drug Induced, and View All.



**Skin of Color Toggle**  
Switch the differential results from all skin types to skin of color to display images that best match your patient.

## Differential Builder Features

**CHIEF COMPLAINT**  
The chief complaint, entered in the search bar on the VisualDx homepage, is the main symptom that brings your patient to see you.

**ENTER FINDINGS**  
The differential builder questions are tailored for each chief complaint. For example, "rash" will bring up questions about lesions, while "vomiting" will bring up questions about vitals and a patient's physical exam. Select the appropriate symptoms experienced by your patient.



**PATIENT INFO**  
Specify patient age and sex to ensure that diagnoses are tailored to your patient.

**EDIT FINDINGS**  
As you enter a patient's symptoms (or findings), they appear here. To make a finding required in your differential results, click the circle on the left to make it turn green. To remove a finding, click the "x" on the right.
