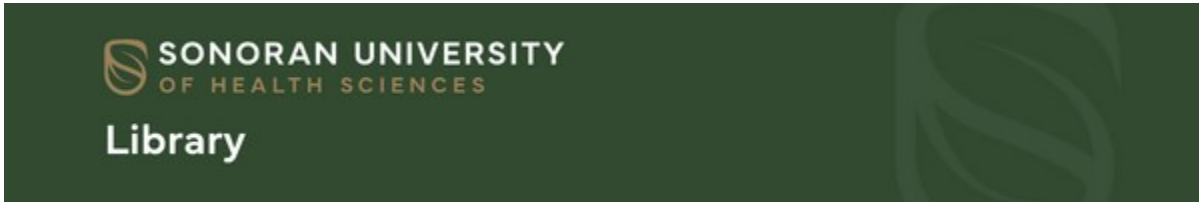

### **GOT CHARGERS ?**

Do you have some old laptop or phone charges laying around cluttering your space? They work but they are no longer compatible with your upgraded devices? Please consider donating them to the Library. They must work. The Library can make them available to your classmates to use in urgent circumstances. Again, we need them to function. Please consider giving them to the Library. ### **TECH TIP**

Often, when experiencing technical issues with your devices, account logons, and more, any one, or all three, of the following tips can make a significant difference in the successful functionality of your device.

1. Clear your Cache – Regularly clear your cache, browsing history, cookies, etc. This can definitely improve the functionality of your computer and browser. (side-tip: you don't necessarily have to clear your saved usernames/passwords)
2. Close your Browser(s) – Regularly close all your Browser(s), and/or Browsing Tabs. Leaving your Browser(s) and Browsing Tabs open over an extended period of time can adversely affect your devices performance.
3. Reboot/Restart– Regularly turn-off/restart your device. A basic Reboot or Restart refreshes your device. It clears memory, and stops any apps performing in the background eating up RAM space.

### **DRY ERASE MARKERS**

Dry Erase Markers are available in the Library for a limited check-out period of 24 hours. When you are done with the markers, please return the markers directly to staff, or to the Indoor Library Book drop. This can be found in the Lim Commons, Second Floor, the Book Drop Slot, a metal handle on the wall, is located to the far right of the library entrance (at the east end of the hall). Make sure you are returning 4 markers (black, red, green, blue) and an eraser in the Sonoran University Library bag with ID barcode number. Kits returned late or incomplete will be assessed fees to the borrower.

# BATES' VISUAL GUIDE TO Physical Examination

Available through the Library page on MySonoran, this program / database can help with the CLPR courses, Clinical Entry/Exit, and other Point-of-Care Doctor/Patient interaction learning.

Now in its Fifth Edition and featuring completely reshot content and new clinical skills videos, **Bates' Visual Guide** delivers head-to-toe and systems-based physical examination techniques for the (Advanced) Assessment or Introduction to Clinical Medicine course. The site features more than 8 hours of video content. Students and faculty in medical, nursing, and related programs will appreciate the careful attention to clinical accuracy, as well as the range of patient types profiled in the series. Institutions will benefit from the online delivery of content—available for the first time via IP-authenticated or referring URL access—allowing their users to view the videos from any web-based location or device. Lynn Bickley, MD, author of *Bates' Guide to Physical Examination and History Taking*, serves as advisor to the project, ensuring the clinical content and its evidence-based origins are maintained. Dr. Bickley also worked with the professionals and actors herein to present a “patient-first” approach to the physical exam. When paired with the Bates' text, which is available in a range of print and digital formats, **Bates' Visual Guide** serves as a complete learning solution for assessment instruction and student preparedness for the boards and the patient encounter.

In April 2022, 27 new videos were added to the Sonoran University Library's **Bates' Visual Guide** subscription.

You are still required to schedule an appointment date, time and length of time, in order to come in to utilize the Library Study Rooms only. If you are unable to keep your appointment, it is absolutely essential that you contact us at your earliest possible convenience to cancel. Available appointment spots are limited.
