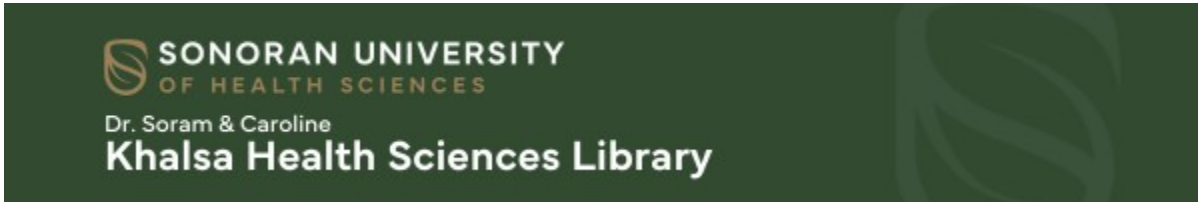

JOURNAL ARTICLES RESEARCH / INTERLIBRARY LOAN

Journal Articles Research : Learn about the several resources the Library subscribes to which will help you conduct a more successful research for Full Text Journal Articles. Search any of them separately, or utilize [iSearch](#) for a more comprehensive search of all of the Library's Journals resources. And when the Library's resources prove unsuccessful, then learn about the many Free databases and other online resources that could prove beneficial. Additionally, the Library Staff is happy to instruct you personally on how to conduct a thorough research in the Library's resources, and the resources easily available online elsewhere.

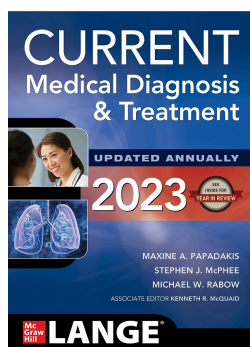
Interlibrary Loan : When all other options prove unsuccessful, then utilize the Sonoran University Library's Interlibrary Loan Services to obtain your most desired medical journal article. Be aware that the Library requires the most fundamental citation information for each article. Also, the Library has now created an online form as a third option for submitting article requests, when the features through PubMed and [iSearch](#) are not applicable. Please be aware that if you do not provide the necessary citation information, we will be unable to locate your requested article and be forced to reject and return your request to you for more information. Please be sure to exhaust all other options for locating an article before submitting a request to the Library.

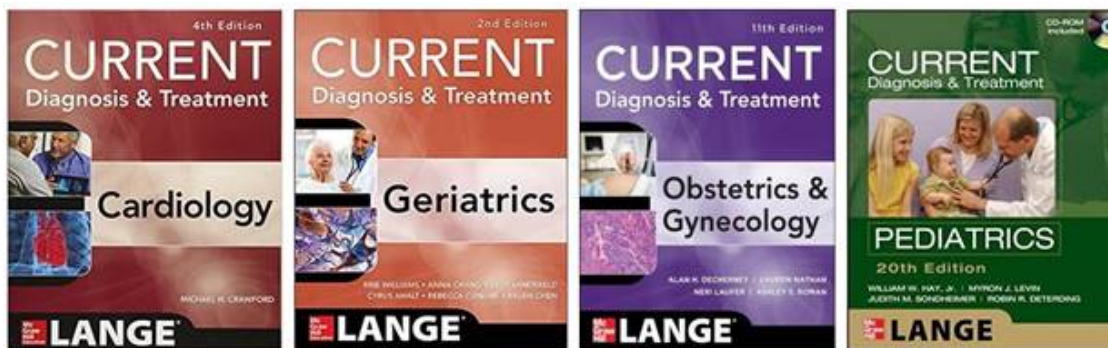

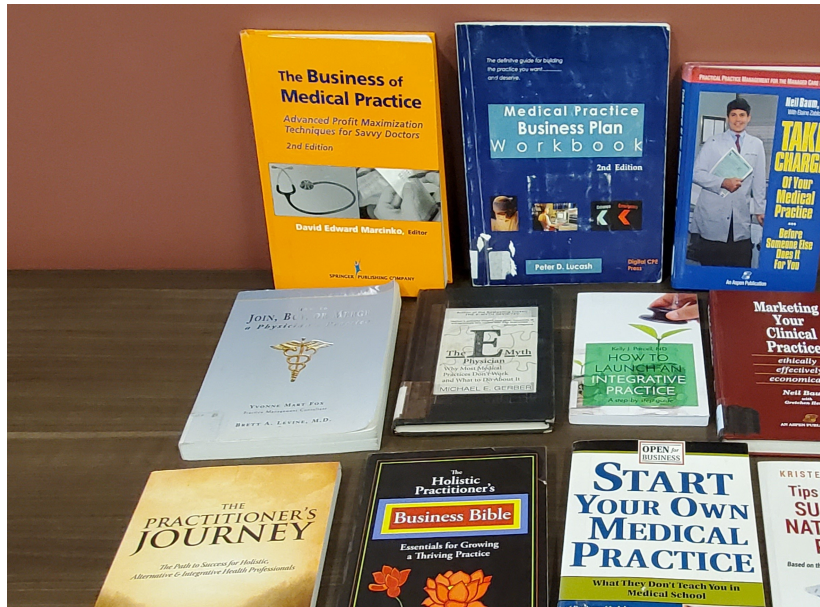

FreeBooks4Doctors was created to promote the free availability of medical books on the Internet. They welcome comments and suggestions. Currently this site has 370 books, and 5088 medical journal back-issues, organized by topic or rating, there are also many books and journals in a variety of languages. Many are available as downloadable PDFs, and some are available as mobile apps. There is also an app for the site in general. [Clinical Pharmacology](#) is a point-of-care database consisting of drug information, drug interactions, IV compatibility, patient education, and more. It is accessible off campus with your library account access. Or, if you wish, you can register to create your unique account profile for off campus use. You can try this while off campus, but it might be you must be on campus, connected to the Sonoran University wi-fi, to create this account, and you must register with your Sonoran email.

DAMAGED / LOST LIBRARY ITEMS

Occasionally, items are returned damaged. Often, they may be water damaged; in fact we have had books still damp when returned (so we know they weren't checked out in that condition). Please be respectful and mindful of the Sonoran University Library's items when they are in your possession. Your fellow borrowers are counting on us having the items on the shelf and in good condition when they need them as well.

Be aware that there is a \$10.00 damage fee, plus a \$5.00 processing fee. If the item is deemed not repairable, destroyed, then there is a replacement fee in the amount of the purchase value of the item, plus a \$5.00 processing fee. Costs can add up, so please take care of the items you check-out of the Library.

APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED CANCELLATION ESSENTIAL

The Library is openly accessible. No appointment required for the open use area, including the copier/printer, computers, etc.

Library Study Rooms are **NOT** available on a 'first-come, first-serve' basis. A Reservation is **required**. Please make sure that you are [reserving study rooms inside the Library](#) due to space limitations and high demand.

You are still required to schedule an appointment date, time and length of time, in order to come in to utilize the Library Study Rooms only. If you are unable to keep your appointment, it is absolutely essential that you contact us at your earliest possible convenience to cancel. Available appointment spots are limited.

For any Library questions or assistance, please contact the library by e-mail as the primary method of communication. Due to the library's limited hours and staffing, the library staff is more likely to be able to respond by e-mail at most any time in the order they are received; though delays may occur.
